Spring has Sprung!

Spring has arrived and with it comes warmer temperatures! As you are planning your spring cleaning please note the following items that need to be in compliance with our goals for a beautiful, valuable community and governing documents. In order to ensure you do not get a violation letter from Sentry Management, please make sure the following items are taken care of by April 1, 2020.

- Mailboxes- Please make sure these are clean, painted and numbers are visible.
- The exterior surfaces of your home need to be cleaned/maintained. No visible mold/mildew should be seen on the siding.
- Any peeling paint on siding or trim should be addressed as well. Faded shutters may need a coat of paint or cleaned with a restore product to bring back the original color.
- Discard any dead shrubs & plants that did not make it through the winter.
- Trash bins are not to be stored in front of your home.
- Prune shrubs & plants so they do not out grow their space.

<u>Architectural Review Committee (ARC) Reminder</u>

Please make sure you submit an ARC request form for any exterior changes. Approval must be given before you can begin your project (roof color replacement, driveway extension, patio improvements, color changes to siding or front door, etc.). Community Courtesies

If you have received 2 violation letters about the same violation issue, you will be scheduled for a hearing in front of the HOA Board. This hearing is your chance to explain any extenuating circumstances or confirm that you have corrected the violation. No decisions about your case will be made at the hearing. If fines are assessed, Sentry will send you a letter explaining the fine. Please remember that any unpaid fines can result in a lien on your property and ultimately foreclosure of the property. The fines are in place to help enforce neighborhood rules, not to punish homeowners. Please be considerate and attend to any violations you may be encountering.

RV Lot update

The RV Lot will undergo reconstruction of the entrance from Monday March 16 through Friday March 20. Please be aware that construction vehicles may block the roundabout at times during this next week. Once new concrete is poured at the entrance, it will need to cure for one week. Please be patient with homeowners who may be parking their vehicles in their driveway, street or at the pool parking lot. They will be exempt from fines from March 14-26th.
