POOL RULES

Pool Hours: 10:00AM – 8:00 PM

All Homeowners and Guests use the pool at their **OWN RISK**. The pool will be open Sunday, May 24, 2020 until Sunday, September 20, 2020; weather permitting.

There are no lifeguards on duty at the pool.

All Homeowners are responsible for their pool access card and badges to access the pool facility and all replacement costs incurred. **Access card replacement is \$25.** Please contact our community manager, Amy Johnson at Sentry Management, 919-790-8000 or ajohnson@sentrymgt.com

HOMEOWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CONDUCT AND THE CONDUCT OF THEIR GUESTS. HOMEOWNERS WILL BE CHARGED MAINTENANCE COSTS FOR ANY DAMAGE, DESTRUCTION, OR LOSS OF USE CAUSED BY THEMSELVES OR THEIR GUESTS. HOMEOWNERS CAN LOSE POOL PRIVILEGES AS A RESULT OF THEIR OR THEIR GUESTS CONDUCT.

POOL RULES

ABSOLUTELY NO GLASS IS PERMITTED IN THE POOL AREA. Attendants have the right to check coolers, bags and any containers at any time. Anyone found with glass will be asked to remove it from the pool area. Repeat infractions of bringing glass can result in fines and loss of pool privileges for up to 12 months.

Anyone who breaks glass on the pool deck will be responsible for the cost of the cleaning of the pool including draining, cost of water to refill and any maintenance to the pool equipment to the standards required by Wake County as laid out in Section 15 (a) of the Wake County Dept. of Environmental Services Regulations Governing Swimming Pools

All non-toilet trained **children MUST wear** snug fitting rubber pants over their diapers or “swim diapers” any time they are in the pool area. Do **NOT** change diapers in the pool area. Please change diapers and discard them in the rest rooms. As per the Wake County Health Department, it is mandatory for the pool to close if fecal contamination occurs. The homeowner will be responsible for the entire cost of maintenance required by Wake County as laid out in Section 9 (k) of the Wake County Dept. of Environmental Services Regulations Governing Swimming Pools

The bathhouse will be locked at all times when there is no attendant. If you are last to leave, please make sure the door is closed. To get the code to enter the bathroom area, please contact our community manager, Amy Johnson.

Playing or loitering in the bathhouse is **NOT** permitted

Pets and other animals are not allowed to enter the pool area.

Persons with band-aids, open wounds, sores or skin infections will **NOT** be permitted in the pool.

Children under the age of 16 years **MUST** be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult.

Members under the age of 18 years who bring guests to the pool must be accompanied by an adult. **All members are responsible for the behavior of their guests.** Homeowners are allowed to bring up to 4 guests, but for 'group party situations', the total number of guests shall not exceed 10. Deviations from this are at the discretion of the attendant and/or HOA board, based on pool load at the time. Please clean up your trash as you leave.

Only one person is allowed on the diving board or slide at any time. Swimming under the diving board or slide and hanging on or playing around the diving board and slide is **NOT** permitted. **ABSOLUTELY NO DIVING FROM SLIDE**, you will be asked to leave the pool & may lose pool privileges for up to 30 days.

Gum chewing is **NOT** permitted in the pool or on the pool deck.

Running, profanity, improper conduct, or any behavior that is potentially dangerous is **NOT** permitted. Inappropriate displays of public affection will be considered improper conduct.

Small inflatable devices or pool toys **ARE** permitted. Large rafts or boats are **NOT** permitted. No inflatable devices on the slide or diving board.

The patio furniture must not be used as playground equipment. Do not put patio furniture in the baby pool.

Skateboards, bicycles, and roller blades are **NOT** permitted in the pool area. Bicycles are to be parked in the designated bike rack and **NOT** on the sidewalks.

Audio devices must be played at a low volume or you will be asked to turn it off.

Swimsuits **ARE REQUIRED** for swimming. No cut-offs or street clothes are allowed in the pool. To maintain a family environment we request no thongs or excessively revealing swimsuits.

Hanging or playing on the ropes/lines is **NOT** permitted. Replacement cost of \$500 will be charged to those found responsible for damaging a rope assembly.

All persons using the swimming pool should take a shower **BEFORE** entering the pool, especially if using tanning oils. Showers are located in the bathrooms.

Adult lap swimmers have priority in the roped off lanes. These designated roped areas are to be used by lap swimmers only. Exceptions may be made during extremely busy times.

There is **NO SMOKING** permitted in or around the pool or clubhouse. Smoking will be limited to designated areas in front of the Clubhouse. This includes vaping.

In the event of a storm/thunder, everyone **MUST** clear the pool until safe conditions return. If an attendant is present, they will tell you when it is safe to re-enter the pool.

NO SPORT EQUIPMENT allowed in the pool area at any time – soccer balls, footballs, lacrosse sticks, baseballs, tennis rackets, etc.

Only toys intended for pool use are allowed to be used in the pool area

Please do not open the gate for anyone. All residents must use their key card to access the pool. By admitting someone without a key, you may be letting a non-resident in or someone who has lost their privileges.

NO food in the pool. Food is to be consumed at least 3 feet away from the pool edge.

SLIDE RULES are posted and **MUST be obeyed.**

- ONLY ONE (1) RIDER AT A TIME ON THE SLIDE
- DO NOT CLIMB SLIDE LADDER UNTIL THE PERSON AHEAD OF YOU HAS ENTERED THE WATER
- SLIDE FEET FIRST FROM A SITTING OR LAYING DOWN POSITION ONLY
- ALWAYS ENTER THE POOL FEET FIRST
- DO NOT STAND KNEEL OR STOP ON THE SLIDE
- ABSOLUTELY NO JUMPING OR DIVING FROM ANY AREA OF THE SLIDE; THIS WILL RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM THE POOL
- DO NOT CLIMB UP THE SLIDE FROM ANY AREA OTHER THAN THE LADDER
- THE USE OF ITEMS NOT INTENDED FOR POOL USE IS PROHIBITED – THIS INCLUDES BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO: BOATING TUBES, BOOGIES BOARDS, RAFTS, ETC.

POOL & SLIDE RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE FOR THE SAFETY AND ENJOYMENT OF EVERYONE IN THE WELLINGTON PARK COMMUNITY.

Our pool staff is there to keep us safe and enforce the rules. *They are NOT lifeguards.* Please follow their instructions and abide by the pool & slide rules. All Members are responsible for making sure their guests know and follow the rules.

Anyone who fails to follow pool staff's instructions, bullies or harasses the pool staff will be called to a hearing before the HOA Board which can result in loss of all recreational privileges for up to 60 days, including use of the pool.
