There is a lot happening in our community! In fact, so much is happening we need an additional newsletter to update you.

Updated covenants: With the last push for collecting covenant votes, we were able to reach the number we needed to pass the proposed updates to our restrictive covenants. We collected 188 Yes votes and 32 No votes. Thank you to everyone who helped with this big project! The updated covenants are posted on the Documents page of the Wellington Park website as well as attached to this email for your reference. We only updated 7 items within the restrictive covenants. We did not change any of the general covenants.
