Chris' Corner

Removing Large Bathroom Mirrors

I wanted to include this since my wife saw this posted question online. One of our Wellington Park homeowners was experiencing difficulties with removing the large wall mirrors that are in many of our neighborhood homes. If you're trying to remove one of these for replacement, it's fairly simple to do, if you just take the time to prep the mirror properly. I've included a link to a quick 2.5 minute below, visually illustrating how to do this.

DIY tip –

- A. Tape up the mirror in a checkerboard pattern, making sure to reinforce the edges with extra tape. Better yet, you can even tape the entire mirror face with heavy duty packing tape as well.
- B. Place wooden shims in the gaps between the wall & mirror.
- C. Use a pry bar to slowly and steadily work from the top edges of the mirror, and begin prying it away from the wall. You can stick another shim between the pry bar and the wall to protect your sheetrock as you do this. You can also use piano wire to help get behind the mirror, and split the adhesive from the wall.
- D. As the mirror gets loose, be sure to support it from the top to keep it from falling and breaking.
