#### **ANNOUNCEMENTS:**

The HOA Board voted, at the October meeting, to move the **annual meeting and board elections** to the third Monday of March going forward. The **pond dredging project** will be starting November 1<sup>st</sup>. The Kris Bass Engineering firm will be working around the small pond on Wellingborough & the large pond on Forest Park Way. We will let you know if traffic will be impacted by their work. After the engineering firm writes up the scope of work needed, a dredging company will come in and remove the built up silt. This project is expected to take up to a year.
