The **next HOA Board meeting** will be Monday April 4 at the clubhouse. The open community meeting starts at 7:00pm.

The Board voted to go without a pool attendant this season. The difference in cost between having an attendant & not having an attendant is \$17,084. Since our residents have been so responsible

during the past 2 seasons with following the COVID rules, we thought we would try to save some money and invest in a new video monitoring system (\$3,825) this season. The pool opens May 14. They are not intended for swimming and are not treated make it safe for people. Please tell your children to only fish in the clubhouse pond & do not remove the rocks around the ponds.

We have had some complaints about excessive barking from dogs & overnight barking. There is nothing the HOA can do about this so we encourage neighbors to talk to each other and cooperate with each other to keep dogs inside overnight and to attend to dogs who are barking excessively.
