Our clubhouse got a refresh in October! The Board budgeted \$6,500 for the refresh which included new carpeting, paint in all the areas of the clubhouse, new curtains and new curtain rods. The total came to \$6,657.16. Come see it at the next Board meeting!

The WP 2025 budget ratification process will be held at the December 2nd HOA meeting. This meeting is required by the North Carolina Planned Community Act (NCGS § 47F-3-116). It allows homeowners to comment on or reject the proposed budget. The budget is ratified unless a majority of owners reject it. If rejected, the association continues to use the previously ratified budget until a new one is approved.

Reminder: We have permission from the owner of the fallen tree on the large pond to allow homeowners to cut it up and use it for their own purpose. If you are going to cut some for yourself, please take care to clean up the area after yourself.
